Highlights:

### Storytimes:

Attendance for our incredibly popular storytimes continues to climb, with over 250 in attendance each month! The program has been expanded to provide this vital early literacy support three times per week for babies, toddlers and preschoolers and their parents/caregivers.

### Screen Free Week Celebration:

Our annual celebration of living unplugged featured a different activity each day for families and kids, including a hike with East Bay Regional Parks, a Spring-themed carnival, and a teen board game night. 145 library users participated!

### Oakley Library Youth Squad (OLYS):

Oakley Library's teens are service minded, working hard to plan and put on multiple events for our city's children and teens, including the annual Howl-la-la-boo Halloween Party and the Spring Carnival.

### Discover and Go:

137 local families have used this terrific new museum pass program, which allows library users to obtain free passes to Bay Area museums and cultural institutions.

The Friends of the Oakley Library (FOOLS) have created brochures, mailers, a logo, and more as part of their brand new capital campaign, "Our New Library Starts With One Dollar," to raise funds for a new community library facility.
